CON-WAY TRUCKLOAD AND CON-WAY MULTIMODAL LAUNCH INTERMODAL SERVICE




A customer in Indiana with a shipment for Monterrey, Mexico contacts either Con-way Truckload or Con-way Multimodal to arrange service.

Con-way Multimodal surveys its system, locates capacity and books the load with the railroad, also arranging for a container if the customer needs it.



A Con-way Truckload truck and driver (or another partner of Con-way Multimodal) then is dispatched to the customer to pick up the load (or deliver an empty container).




At the intermodal ramp outside of Monterrey, a drayage driver arranged by and under the direction of CFI Logística picks up the container (which has been pre-cleared through the customer's customs broker working with CFI Logística's office), proceeds to the customer and delivers the shipment.











A similar operational scenario would come into play for shipments inbound to the U.S. from Mexico, with a Con-way Truckload truck and driver (or other Con-way Multimodal drayage partner) making the final-mile delivery from the intermodal ramp to the customer in the U.S.
